Purpose of the Job

- To play a key role within the Mind in West Essex management team in the development and project management of pilot projects and the setup of new services.
- To play a key role in all aspects of general service development including but not limited to use of CRM systems, development of meaningful data sets and embedding quality throughout the organisation.
- To engage in existing networks through which the vision and objectives of Mind in West Essex will be promoted and developed.
- To work with the fundraising team to play a part in identifying and securing funding streams for projects that we have an ambition to develop.

Responsibilities

- To follow all of Mind in West Essex policies and procedures.
- To work closely with the CEO and Senior Management Team in the development and delivery of the Strategic and Operational Plans.
- To contribute to the ongoing review cycle of Mind in West Essex Policies and Procedures
- To Project Manage the setting up of small projects and new services as required
- To assume line management responsibility for a number of staff as and when appropriate
- To take a lead in the Mind Quality Process (MQM)
- To develop and support the collation and analysis of statistical, quantitative and qualitative data as required for both internal and external performance and contract monitoring purposes
- To attend and participate in support, supervision and appraisal
- To participate in any training and education required for the role.
- To provide reports for the Mind in West Essex Board of trustees as required

- Self-motivated with the initiative and ability to manage own workload.

- Driving licence and access to a vehicle, and/or ability to travel throughout Essex and Hertfordshire.
